The second biennial ***Guilford Performing Arts Festival*** (GPAF) is built around a core of regional and local talent—musicians and composers, dancers and choreographers, playwrights and actors, poets and authors, teachers and storytellers—many of whom have national-scale careers and infrequently perform close to home. The 2019 roster includes 44 musical acts in a wide range of genres; 15 artists in drama, musical theater, the literary arts and spoken word; eight dance companies; and aerial circus acts, interactive music and theater, mindreading and a bread-making demonstration. The majority of the artists are from Connecticut; others are traveling from New York City, the Hudson Valley and outside Boston.

***Madison Lyric Stage*** is a 501(c)(3) non-profit arts collective for the Shoreline of Connecticut. Its mission is to present professional-quality entertainment from the worlds of opera, musical theatre, and drama.
